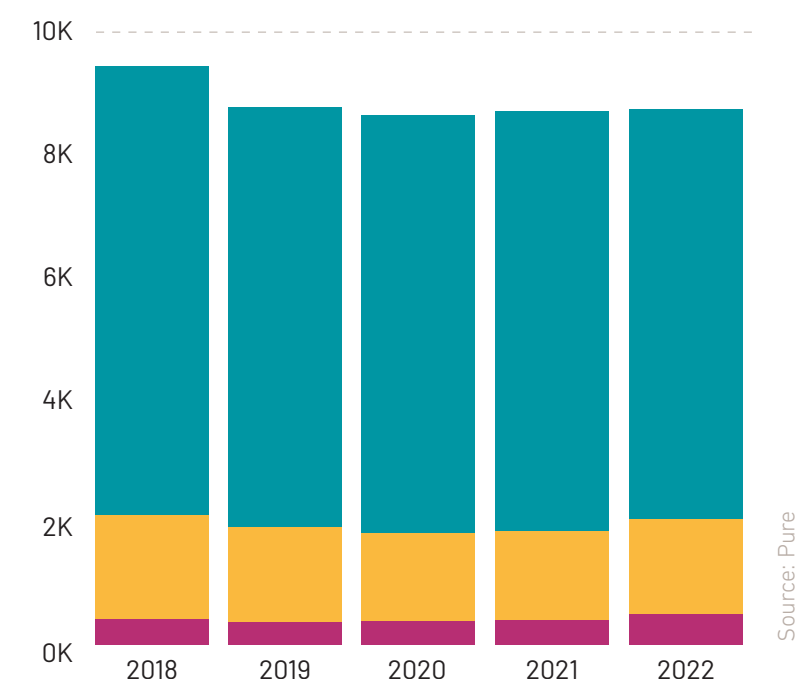

Collaboration, innovation, visibility, and openness is exactly what constitutes the core of the European Agreement on Reforming Research Assessment (ARRA), which AAU signed earlier this year. ARRA and the accompanying membership of the Coalition for Advancing Research Assessment (CoARA) has inspired the university's new research indicator that rewards diversity in research.

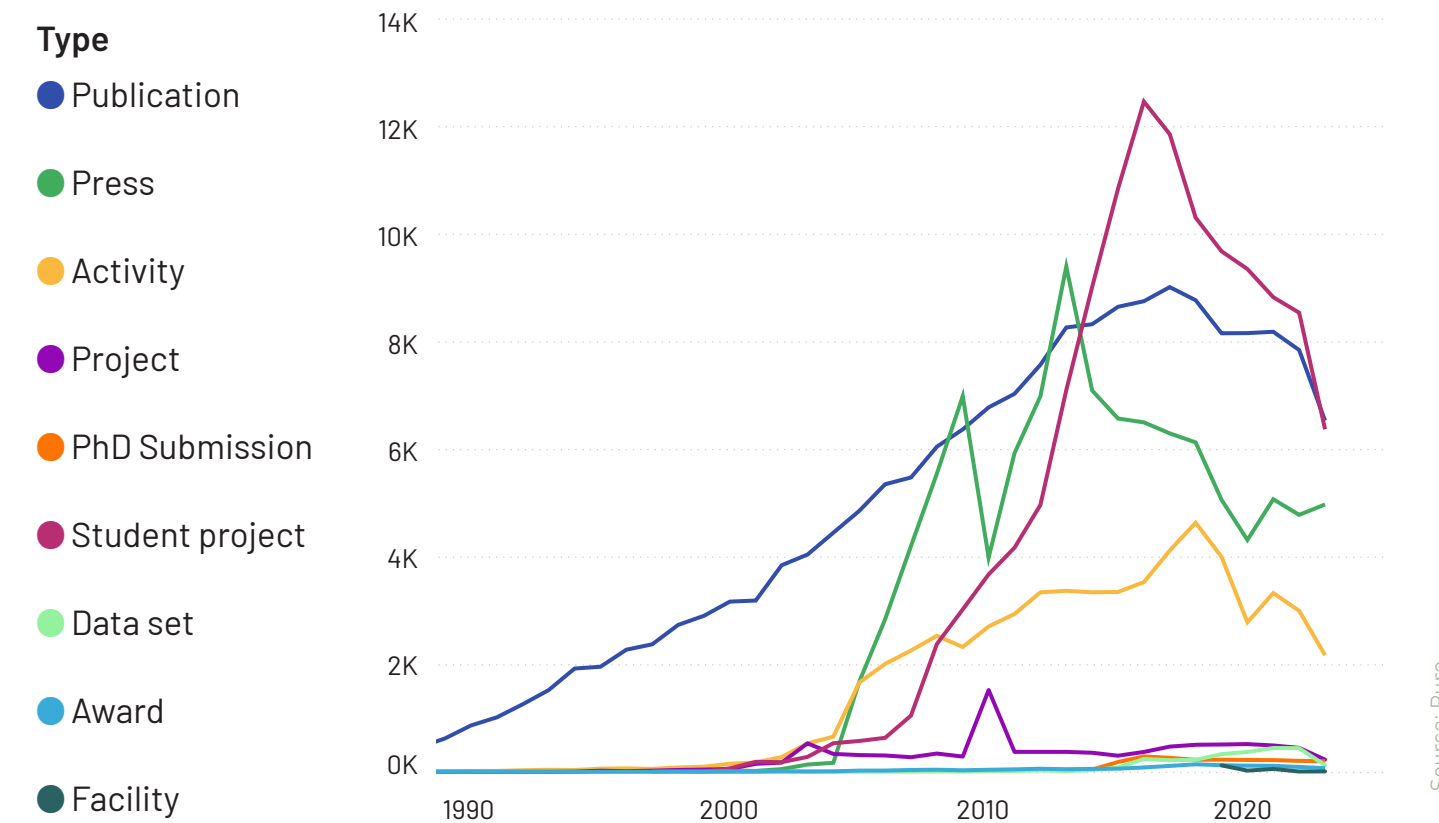
Number of publications per annum and author category

Number of entries per annum and content type

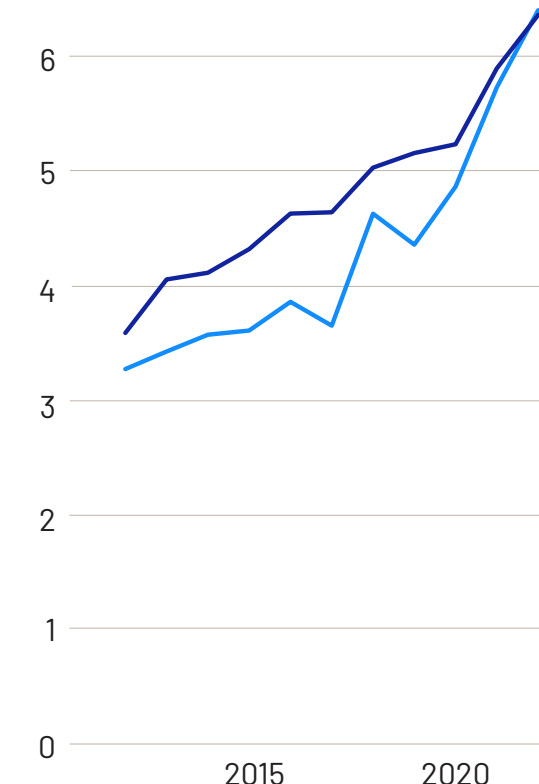

Female Male



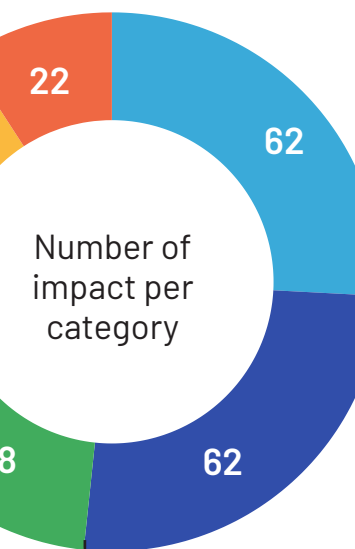

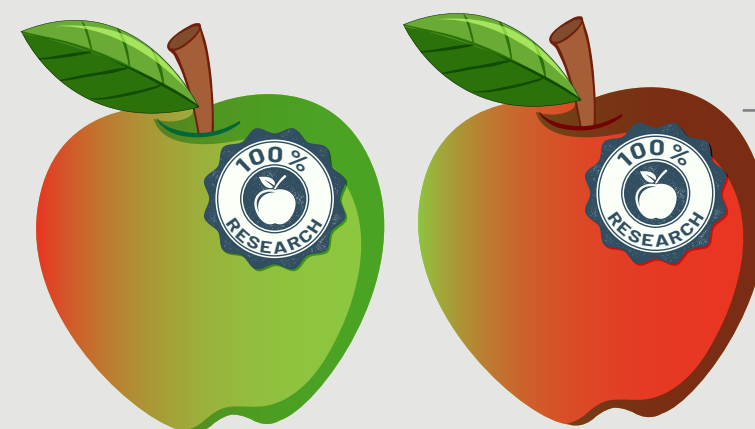

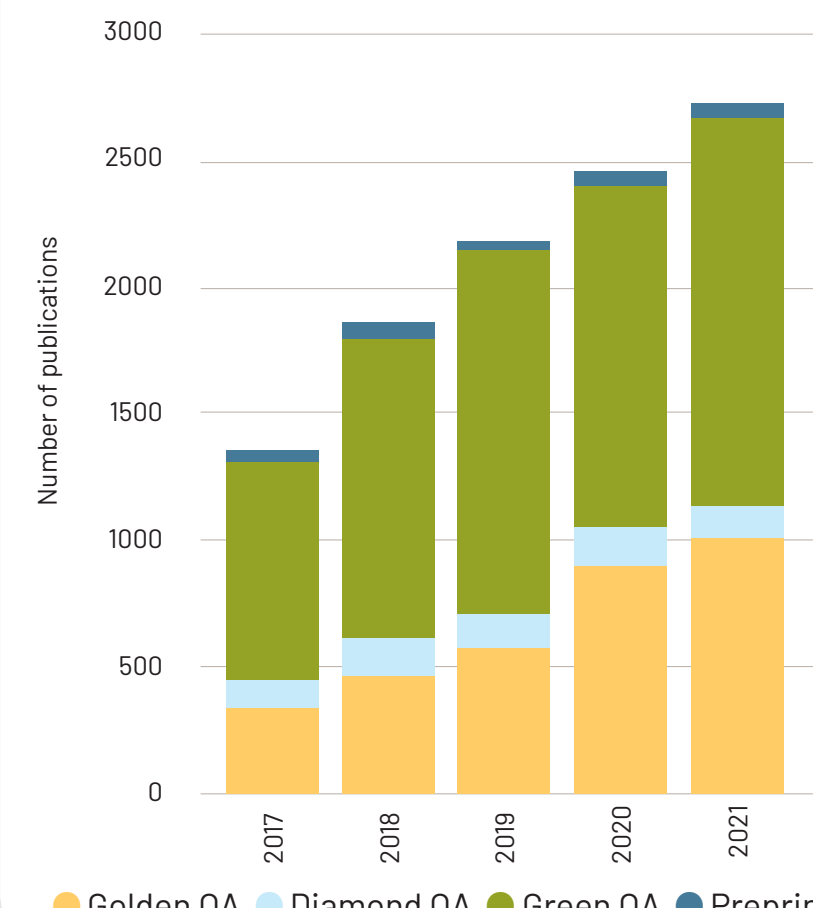
97,2% of research from Department of Chemistry and Bioscience is indexed in Scopus
